In the early 1960s U Thant was Secretary General of the United Nations. A Buddhist and a man of peace he once said "No difficult problem can be solved to the satisfaction of all sides. We live in an imperfect world and have to accept imperfect solutions. Which become more acceptable as we learn to live with them, and as time passes by."

A half century ago this Catholic boy from Hope, North Dakota fell in love with a Lutheran girl from Makoti, North Dakota. It didn't matter to me where we were married at. It could have been by a Judge or at a wedding chapel in Las Vegas and I would have been happy. 

Pastor Sylvia's Parables



I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ." Philippians 1:3-6

By my calculations, as of June 1, we will have been in ministry together at Faith Lutheran Church for 2,280 days! Amazing! Much has happened over those days - joy and laughter, tears and sorrow, new life, sickness and death, and

a million other ordinary and extraordinary moments of life together in Christian community. I am so grateful for all that we have shared so far, and all that will we will continue to share together into the future. This past year in particular has been one of great joy for me as your pastor, as we emerge from the constraints of the pandemic and enjoy each other's presence anew.

As many of you know, being a pastor comes with a particular set of joys, but also a particular set of burdens: We carry the knowledge of the cares and concerns of the whole congregation and all its people. Death and sickness (and modern technology!) don't have much regard for days off or established plans. Leadership of any community, but especially of faith communities, can be as draining as it is life-giving at times.

This is why congregations are encouraged to offer sabbatical leave to their pastors after five or more years of service. It is a wonderful gift that enables us to have some respite from the constancy of being on-call, the weight of pastoral care concerns, and the responsibilities of planning, leading, and decision-making. It is an opportunity for us to re-set, to refocus our spiritual lives, and to rest, so that we can return to our beloved communities renewed for the good work of being God's people together.

Faith Lutheran offers three months of sabbatical to pastors who have served the congregation for six years or more. Last year, I was granted a month of my sabbatical early as renewal leave, due to the unusual circumstances of the pandemic, on top of the senior pastor transition that took place in 2019-2020. This summer, I will receive the remainder of that sabbatical. I will be on leave from June 14 through August 13. I will not be answering church-related emails, phone messages, or texts during this time. Pastor Sharon Korsmo will be assisting Pastor Derek in caring for the needs of the congregation while I am away. My plan for these two months is to spend time with family and friends, garden, rest, pray, and read. Seth and I will also be taking two trips: one to Spain in July and another to Montana to spend time with my family at the beginning of August.

As much as I am looking forward to this time away, I am also looking forward to being back with you at its end with new energy, excitement, and resources for our ministry together. While we are apart, know that I will carry you with joy and gratitude in my heart and in my prayers. I ask that you will do the same for me.

Thank you for this gift, and for calling me to be one of your pastors. May this summer be full of blessings for each of you and for our congregation.


