

9th Grade Confirmation Covenant 2019-2020

Faith Lutheran Church

Confirmation at Faith Lutheran Church is a three-year process of faith formation, with the aim of deepening faith such that those who go through it are willing and able to make an affirmation of their baptism in front of the congregation at the end of their three years.

All confirmation students are expected to:

- Attend class and other required activities
- Attend worship regularly
- Actively participate in class discussions and activities
- Respect the class leader, other students, and the classroom space
- Complete all requirements in a timely manner

Requirements of 9th grade confirmation students:

- Attend monthly class sessions on Wednesday nights
- Serve as an acolyte or communion assistant for worship services
- Complete 12 worship notes
- Attend parent-student classes on November 6, January 8, and March 4 at 6:00pm
- Meet with Mentor 4 times
 - Kick-off event @ CROP Walk, Oct. 13th 12:30pm, Good Shepherd Lutheran
 - 3 other meetings: (1) Worship, (2) Faith conversation, (3) Other FLC activity
- Complete 4 hours of community service, including serving pizza on Wednesday nights
- Assist with Pie and Coffee Day on Saturday, October 26, 2019 and Easter Breakfast on Sunday, April 12, 2020
- Attend the 9th grade retreat on Saturday, April 4, 2020

Make-up work policy:

- Students who miss a class are expected to arrange a time to meet with Kenny or Pastor Sylvia to go over what was missed.
